 \mathbf{W} hen it comes to the love that God has for us, personally, I like to describe it this way: "He can't help Himself." Let me share with you from my own experience what I mean by this. I love cheesecake and butter pecan ice cream. Because some of my friends know this fact about me, when they want to do something special for me as a token of their appreciation they will surprise me with a home made cheese cake when I hold a meeting in their homes. If I am told to help myself to the cheesecake, trust me, I'm going to eat it, because I cannot help myself. I just like it too much!

I believe that God is so driven by His nature toward us that it is impossible for Him to be any other way. Love is! We mean so much to Him that when He purposed to redeem us from spiritual death, He acknowledged that nothing created or that man holds dear was valuable enough to pay for it. How valuable and dear are we to Him then? In this world a thing is considered as valuable as how much someone is willing to pay for it. Remember the expression, "Somebody's trash is somebody else's treasure." God's appraisal for our redemption is beyond human potential: it is impossible. Consider the following Scriptures:

"6They that trust in their wealth, and boast themselves in the multitude of their riches; 7None of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him: *(For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceaseth for ever:)" Psalm 49:6-8 KJV

Verse eight in the Amplified Bibles reads,

"For the ransom of a life is too costly, and [the price one can pay] can never suffice."

f There is not enough silver, gold, precious stones, oil, you name it, that's enough to redeem one single soul. Let us make the assumption that the whole world could come to an agreement to sacrifice themselves so that at least one person of the entire human race could be saved. That would not be enough! Romans 3:23 sheds some light in the

matter, "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

So what value has God placed on us? **Himself!** Glory be to God forevermore!

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." John 3:16

Oh yes, He loves us! If we would grasp the reality of this fact it would change our whole view and expectations not only of this life but of the life that is to come when mortality will become the more meaningless.

There are two qualities of God that I ponder many times in amazement. They are not spelled out in the Bible the way I will share them with you and you will be blessed if you are not offended by my approach.

First, God is "hard headed" and secondly God is "narrow minded." I say this because of His determination and drive to love us. Let me explain. When we claim God's promises, more often than not, we pray to him as if he had not made up his mind concerning us and we give the impression that we are trying to convince him to think and act the way he

defines himself in his Word. A waste of time when you think about it carefully.

God is so persuaded of his own words that he cannot draw back from them.

In Matthew 24:35 the Lord declares,

"Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away."

In the book of Numbers 23: 19-20 what the prophet declares is what God declares,

"19God is not a man, that He should lie; neither the son of man, that He should repent: hath He said, and shall He not do it? or hath He spoken, and shall He not make it good? 20Behold, I have received commandment to bless: and He hath blessed; and I cannot reverse it."

If He redeemed us from the position that we were in when we were not even interested in Him or trusted Him; we should know that He is not going to change His mind concerning us, never!

"4But God, who is rich in mercy, for His great love wherewith He loved us, 5Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) 6And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: 7That in the ages to

come He might shew the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. *For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: *Not of works, lest any man should boast." Ephesians 2:4-9

Is not our Savior awesome or what?

When He stepped into our hearts when we received him as our Lord and Savior, He did not do it blind folded; He knew very well what He was stepping into and there is not anything or any body that can make Him change His mind. Paul caught the revelation of this when he wrote in Romans,

"35Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? ³⁶As it is written, for thy sake we are killed all the day long: we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. ³⁷Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, ³⁹Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God. which is in Christ Jesus our Lord." 
