## Prophecy

A supernatural utterance, speech or message inspired by the Holy Spirit in which the mind, will, plans, purposes or strategy of God are conveyed.

### **The simple gift of prophecy:**

#### **Purpose; 1 Cor. 14:3**

- Edification: supernatural message promoting spiritual growth; the building up of the body of Christ.
- Exhortation: supernatural message in which the listeners are encouraged or urged to pursue some course of action—always prospective or looking to the future.
- Comfort: a supernatural message dealing with trial experiences to strengthen and bring consolation.

It is very important to notice that the simple gift of prophecy is not given for revelation.

### **Prophecy and the prophet's ministry:**

To stand in this office or function he or she must have the revelation gifts as well as prophecy operating in their lives.

#### The gift of the word of knowledge:

A supernatural revelation from God of any fact or event past or present.

The gift of the word of wisdom: A supernatural revelation from God of His mind and purpose present or future.

The gift of the discerning of spirits: A supernatural revelation from God of the presence of activities of the spirit realm whether godly or evil.

### **Personal prophecy in perspective:**

Must be centered on our Lord

Jesus Christ: John 16:13-15; Rev. 19:9-10.

#### Must agree with scripture:

II Peter 1:16-21; Isaiah 8:20; Jeremiah 8:9; John 5:39.

#### Does not lead to bondage:

Rom. 8:15; II Cor. 3:17; Rom. 8:1-2.

#### Gives life: John 6:63; John 10:10

#### Causes you to endure: I Tim

1:18; Luke 2:25-26; II Cor. 3:6;

Ps. 119:49-50 "Remember [fervently] the word and promise to Your servant, on which You have caused me to hope.

This is my comfort and consolation in my affliction, that Your word has revived me and given me life." (Amplified)

Must confirm what the Lord has already laid on your heart or should be confirmed: Acts 15:32 (confirm: to support further); II Cor. 13:1; Acts 13:2.

Must come to pass: Deut. 18:22; Jer. 28:9; Acts 11:27-28.

\*\*\*IMPORTANT: There are occasions in which the prophecy or "word" does not come to pass and we must ask ourselves some questions before labeling it as false. For example: Are the conditions for the fulfillment of the prophecy met? Has there been a change of heart? Was the proper time allowed?

Scriptural examples:

a. The case of King Hezekiah: II Kings 20:1-6; Is 38:1-4.

b. The case of the people of Nineveh: Jonah 3:4-10.

c. The case of Simon the sorcerer: Acts 8:9-24.

Must be judged: I Jn 4:1; Matt. 7:15-20. "Do not quench (suppress or subdue) the (Holy) Spirit. Do not spurn the gifts and utterances of the prophets—do not depreciate prophetic revelations nor despise inspired in-

struction or exhortation or warning. But test and prove all things [until you can recognize] what is good; [to that] hold fast.", I Thess 5:19-21. (Amp)

Timing: No shortcuts. In Gen 15:5 the Lord has promised Abram an heir out of his own bowels, later in Gen. 16:1-5 we see how Sarai, Abram's wife tried to "help" the Lord fulfill his promise by giving her handmaid to her husband to "obtain children" by her. This Sara did to her own hurt. (II Peter 3:9) Whether short or long during the waiting period we can always find comfort encouragement and strength in God's word: Ps 37:3-7; Philp. 1:6; Ps. 62:5.

God's goodness, forbearance and longsuffering: Rom. 2:4. God is not in the habit or business of going around using prophecy to make an example and putting to shame before people his children because they have un-confessed sin in their lives or are actually living in sin.

He can expose sin through prophecy but that is the exception and not the rule. Remember, God deals with the individual according to their heart and not according to someone else's opinion (ISam.16:7). He is not condoning sin nor is He overlooking it. He chooses to reveal his thoughts, his expectations, His very own heart to the person to draw him or her to repentance and thus closer to Him. (Jer. 29:11; Hos. 11:1-4)

The Adversary; Master of deception: II Cor. 11:14-15. Keep in mind that once the Word of God or a word from the Lord is spoken over your life, Satan himself will see to it that doubt and unbelief be part also of your consideration when you meditate on God's impartation to you. (Mark 4:15)

Among others some facts about our adversary are:

**He is:**

**A murderer.**

**A liar-**father of all lies; no truth in him John 8:44.

**A thief;** comes to steal, kill & destroy John 10:10; MK 4:15.

**A worker of signs and lying wonders** II Thess. 2:9.

**As a roaring lion,** walking about, seeking whom he may devour II Peter 5:8.

**A counterfeiter:** transforms himself as an angel of light and his ministers transforms themselves as the ministers of righteousness II Cor. 11:14-15.

**Not invincible:** "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." James 4:7.

**Must be resisted** steadfast in the faith II Peter 5:9; Eph. 6:16; Rom. 16:20; Acts 10:38.

**Scriptural responses to prophecy, examples:**

**a.** II Cor. 15:8 King Asa "took courage and put away all the abominable idols of the land of Juda and Benjamin, and out of the cities which he had taken from mount Ephraim, and renewed the altar of the Lord, that was before the porch of the Lord."

**b.** II Kings 23:3 King Josiah and the people of Judah "made a covenant before the Lord, to walk after the Lord, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book."

**c.** Acts 9:9-11 When Paul was three days with out sight he "neither did eat not drink" and "behold, he prayeth."

**d.** Luke 2:19 "But Mary kept all

these things, and pondered them in her heart."

**e.** Luke 2:25-26 Simeon "was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him."

**Audio tapes:** These are tools provided for accountability, for teaching and as means of encouragement to you to further apply the principles introduced here.

I Cor. 2:4-5 "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God."

I Cor. 1:24 "Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God."
